



## **Sample Differentiated Material for Second Level Students**

The need for support in differentiating materials for students with Down syndrome has been identified by parents, teachers and other educators as the syllabus for second level subjects – as presented in current textbooks and materials – is beyond the level of comprehension and reading ability of many students with Down syndrome.

We have developed booklets which show differentiated segments for a number of subjects: **Home Economics, English, Science, History, Geography** and **Civil, Social and Political Education (CSPE)**.

Each booklet offers a number of ‘sample lessons’.

Additional sample lessons in the form of PowerPoint presentations are available for **Science (Balanced Diet)** and **Home Economics (‘Home Baking’, ‘Milk, Cheese & Eggs’ and ‘The Teeth’)**

They will help teachers provide suitable materials of an appropriate level for teenagers with Down syndrome resulting in better learning outcomes and more inclusion in the classroom.

Our **Introductory Booklet** has information on *Individual Education Plans*, *Strategies for Learning and Teaching*, a *Behaviour Checklist* and information on related issues such as *Hearing* and *Vision*.
